I. Introduction

Shaping Our Appalachian Region, Inc. (SOAR) invites proposals from qualified firms or individuals to conduct a comprehensive overhaul and rewrite of SOAR's strategic plan. This effort aims to clearly define SOAR's short-, medium-, and long-term organizational goals and establish a framework for measuring the direct impact of our initiatives. The selected consultant will work closely with SOAR's leadership, team members, and board representatives throughout the process.

II. Background

SOAR is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to advancing economic mobility for individuals in Eastern Kentucky. Our mission is to transform lives by empowering individuals to secure employment and achieve economic self-sufficiency. SOAR works to break cycles of generational poverty through initiatives focused on workforce development, entrepreneurship, and healthy communities. As SOAR continues to expand its impact, a revised strategic plan is critical to ensuring our work remains focused, measurable, and aligned with long-term regional transformation.

III. Scope of Work

The selected consultant will facilitate a strategic planning process that includes the following components:

1. Assessment & Stakeholder Engagement

- Conduct interviews and focus groups with SOAR leadership, staff, board members, and key stakeholders.
- o Review existing strategic documents, reports, and performance metrics.
- o Identify strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats (SWOT analysis).

2. Strategic Framework Development

- Define SOAR's short-term (1-3 years), medium-term (3-5 years), and long-term (5+ years) goals with clear objectives and measurable outcomes.
- o Establish key performance indicators (KPIs) to track impact.
- Ensure alignment with SOAR's vision, mission, and priority initiatives.



3. Implementation Plan & Final Deliverable

- Develop a phased implementation plan with action steps and accountability measures.
- o Deliver a comprehensive, visually compelling strategic plan document.
- Present final recommendations to SOAR leadership and board member

IV. Proposal Submission Requirements

Proposals should be submitted in PDF format and must include:

- 1. **Cover Letter** A brief introduction summarizing the firm's qualifications and interest in the project.
- 2. **Experience & Qualifications** A description of relevant experience, including previous strategic planning engagements.
- 3. **Approach & Methodology** A detailed outline of the proposed approach, timeline, and engagement process.
- 4. **Key Personnel** Names and qualifications of individuals who will lead and participate in the project.
- 5. **References** Contact information for at least three references from similar projects.
- 6. **Cost Proposal** A detailed budget, including hourly rates, anticipated travel expenses (if applicable), and total project cost.

V. Evaluation Criteria

Proposals will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Approach & Methodology (30%) Thoughtfulness, feasibility, and alignment with SOAR's needs.
- Experience & Qualifications (25%) Relevant experience, expertise, and past performance.
- Cost Proposal (20%) Cost-effectiveness and overall value.
- Stakeholder Engagement Strategy (10%) Ability to incorporate input from SOAR staff, board members, and community partners.
- **References & Past Work (10%)** Feedback from previous clients and quality of past strategic planning projects.
- **Preference for Eastern Kentucky-Based Consultants (5%)** Proposals from consultants based in or with deep experience in Eastern Kentucky will receive additional consideration.
